First case of COVID-19 reported in Boise County

BOISE COUNTY – Central District Health (CDH) is confirming one case of COVID-19 in a Boise County resident. The individual is a male in his 30s who is reporting mild symptoms, and is recovering at home. Out of respect for the individual, no additional information is available regarding this case. CDH has not declared community transmission in Boise County.

“We have been very fortunate in Boise County to have been at zero cases this far into the pandemic. Now, more than ever, as we watch cases climb in neighboring Ada County, and many other nearby counties, we need to be diligent about protecting our community which hosts visitors, travelers and recreation enthusiasts every day,” said Ryan Stirm, Boise County Commissioner and CDH Board of Health member.
