ECHC Specific Updates:

We voted in the ECHC bylaws and are now operating under a framework! Hooray!

ECHC has a current executive committee: Allan Carroll, Beth Deschene, Christy Acord, which have been the members for about 2 years now. Now that we have bylaws in place, we will be going through the process to vote in new executive committee members. Nominations for Executive Committee members will end on September 30th (not 29th), and voting for new executive committee members will happen at the next upcoming October coalition meeting. There will be three open slots for executive committee nominations. We will also be nominating a Communications Manager. All expectations of these positions will be made clear on the nomination form, so those nominated know their expectations. **Please feel free to nominate self or others (with their consent)** <u>here.</u>

Because we will be voting in new members, it will be important to have updated membership information on file, so all organizations will be completing a new membership form, which will include identifying a proxy to vote in your place on action items, and which committees want to be a part of. All ECHC current members, or those wanting to become members need to fill out this <u>membership agreement</u> **BEFORE OCTOBER 17**th to be able to vote for executive committee and communication manager.

Nutrition Committee:

Solidified Elmore County specific foodbank access information card, which Kelsey is designing, translating, and will be printing for us to distribute. Kelsey is asking about how big we want the card. Wants to size it up, but we don't want to be so big. We think 1/2 sheet will be a good size. Maybe even English and Spanish separate cards. Kelsey will continue to work to get it done.

Cooking Matters classes update: Not successful in getting class in GF, but Desert Sage staff (Anna and Maritza) will be co-hosting classes with CDH at the MH Senior Center Starting September 5th! Please share the information about the class! Desert Sage is really excited to participate! They have pepr sign up sheets and a virtual form for folks to fill out. The class is for adults, but there may be future conversation about starting those partnerships in the schools. CM classes could be good to push with recovery groups.

Substance Use Committee:

Still no coordinator, please let us know if you have someone in mind who might be a good fit for the coordinator position!

Allan provided an update on sub use related things: Allan has engaged with the schools on bringin in and leading CATCH My Breath, working on coordinating with the schools on how to make that happen in MH. Discussed online program potential to bring to GF schools: IPTV KnowVape curriculum? If goes well in MH, then Hope Center might be able to bring CATCH to GF in Spring. Let's chat about bringing this up on Sept 13th PD Day.
