Some highlights from the presentation were:

- There are two housing projects in Mountain Home (Hamilton Manufactured Community, and Falcon's Landing).

Mental Health Committee Updates (Ali): December news article on accessing mental healthcare through insurance was sent to December MH News and GF Times, and El-Wyhee HiLites will add it to the January issue.

Nutrition Committee (Mindy): CDH will be starting a family specific Cooking Matters class for families who have kiddos getting scholarships in the Albion Soccer club. Classes will begin Jan 7th. Hoping to expand Cooking Matters classes to Falcon's landing and other community partners.
