No agencies are currently performing drug checking as a harm reduction strategy within the region. There are currently safe stations in the form of crisis centers and support center resources such as Clarvida Community Crisis Center, Peer Wellness Center and The ROC. Barriers they currently face include funding, capacity, and transportation. Boise PD currently has a behavioral health response team that is taking people to Pathways when appropriate, as well as Meridian PD and the Ada County Sheriff's Office. IDOC is also utilizing MOUD during incarceration.
